- January 2008: EEW introduced wind project to Town of Forest Board
- April 2008: Forest Town Board approved a Wind Development Agreement resolution
- May 2008: Erected a wind monitoring tower
- May 2008- December 2009:
  - o Secured property easements
  - o Updated Town of Forest officials—public meetings and open house.
- August 2010: Agreement with the Town was finalized
- March 2011: New Town Board attempts to rescind the wind project agreements
- April 2011: Highland Wind Farm developers increase the project size from 97.5MW to 102.5MW
  - o State requirements now apply (Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN))
- <u>December 26, 2011:</u> Highland Wind Farm files application for a CPCN with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin
- March 29, 2012: Highland Wind Farm applications deemed "complete" after providing PSCW staff additional information
  - o The PSC now has 180 days to review the project, seek public input and make a decision
  - o PSC deadline can be extended
- <u>September 25, 2012:</u> Anticipated Approval
- Late 4<sup>th</sup> 2012 Quarter: Construction Begins
